



Dear Parents/Carers,

Within this letter you will find information regarding the full return to school on Monday 8th March. All of this information will also be added to a **'return to school'** section on the website.

Start and end times

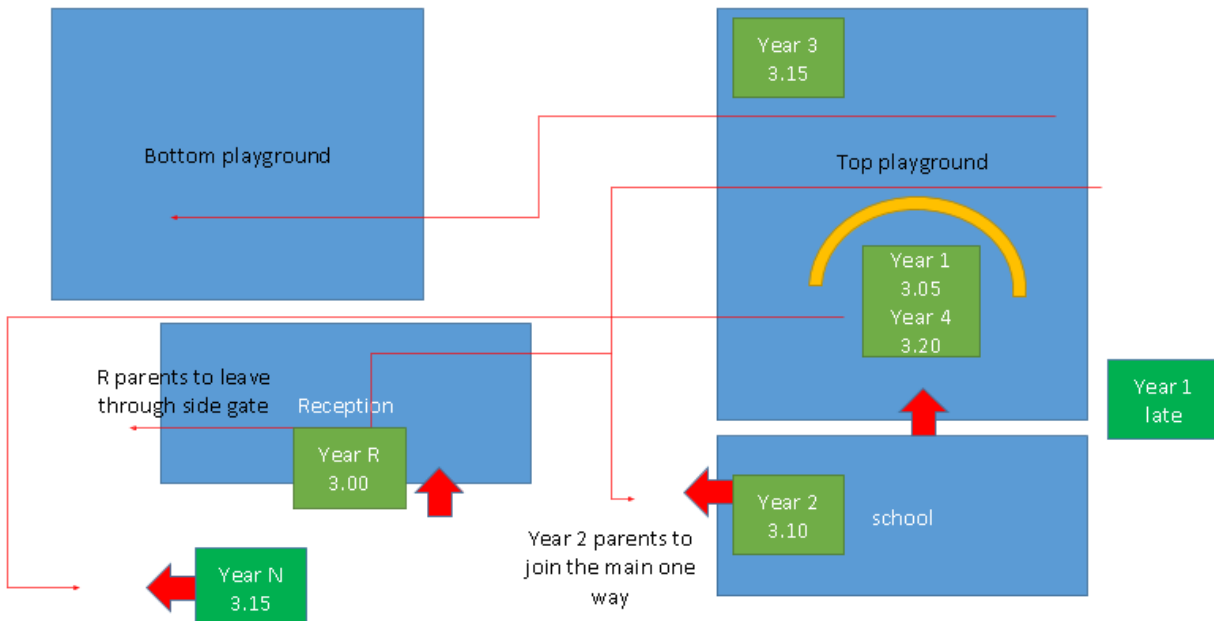
We are continuing to stagger the start and end times of the school day, as this enables us to maintain social distance on the playground. Please see the below table for the start and end times:

	Start	End
Nursery	Morning session 8:45 – 11:45	Afternoon session 12:15 - 3:15
Reception	8:40	3:00
Year 1	8:45	3:05
Year 2	8:50	3:10
Year 3	8:55	3:15
Year 4	9:00	3:20

As before, sibling groups need to be dropped off at the earliest time and collected at the latest time. Every sibling group should have an individual message to clarify this matter.

The collection points for the end of the school day have changed please see the diagram below for information about where to collect your child.

All siblings to stay in classroom with TA as they will be collected at the latest collection time for their family.





Routines

School lunches	Please order lunch for your child on the eduspot (school money) website as usual.
Packed lunch	Children can bring their own packed lunch in a lunchbox.
Water bottles	All pupils will need a water bottle in school. These should be taken home and washed daily.
Book bags	Pupils should continue to bring book bags to school daily. New books should be returned on a Friday and will be allocated once a week on a Friday. Reading diaries will be checked on a Friday.
School uniform	All pupils are expected to wear full school uniform. The classroom windows will continue to be open, so you may wish to add extra layers underneath if it is a cold day.
PE kits	All pupils will need a PE kit and pumps/trainers in school. This will be kept in school for the half term.

Coronavirus

- You should continue to follow the one way system and maintain social distance at all times when on the school premises.
- Masks are to be worn at all times on the school grounds, unless exempt.
- If you or anyone in your household has any symptoms of coronavirus you must not come onto school premises.
- If anyone in your household develops any symptoms you must isolate and get a test as soon as possible.
- If your child or anyone in the house has symptoms and is getting tested, or tests positive, you must inform the school using the covid19@westlands.worcs.sch.uk email address.
- If your child has to isolate, remote learning will be set once you inform the school of the situation. Information about this can be found on the website in the 'return to school' section.
