#### <u>Literacy</u> Reading

Has 2 channelled attention [40-60] Able to follow a story without pictures or props [40-60] Can use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations [40-60] Reading CVC and begin to introduce red words [ 40-60m] Segment sounds in simple words and blend them together [ 40-60] Hears and says initial sounds in words [40-60]

Begins to read words and simple sentences [40-60] Enjoys an increasing range of books [40-60]

#### Writing

Segment the sounds in simple words and blend them together [40-60]

Write captions [40-60]

Begins to break the flow of speech into words [40-60] Uses some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning, representing some sounds correctly and in sequence [40-60]

Write short sentences in meaningful contexts [40-60]

#### **Expressive Arts and Design**

Uses simple tools and techniques competently and appropriately [40-60]

Practices some appropriate safety measures without supervision [40-60]

Selects appropriate resources and adapts work where necessary [40-60]

Experiments to create different textures [40-60] Uses simple techniques competently and appropriately [40-60]

Explore what happens when they mix colours [40-60] Begins to build a repertoire of songs and dances [40-60] Sing songs, make music and dance [ELG]

## Communication and Language:

Listening and attention

Maintains attention, concentrates and sits quietly during appropriate activity. (40-60) Two-channelled attention – can listen and do for short span. (40-60)

Able to follow a story without pictures or props (40-60) Listens and responds to ideas expressed by others in conversation or discussion. (40-60) Follow instructions involving several ideas or actions. Answer 'how' and 'why' questions about their

experiences and in response to stories or events.(ELG)

Using quantities and objects, add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find out the answer [ELG] Begin to use mathematical names for 2d shape, and mathematical terms to describe these shapes [40-60] Beginning to use everyday language related to money [40-60] Recognise, create and describe patterns [ELG]

## Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Explain their own knowledge and understanding [40-60] Confidently speak to others about own interest and opinions [40-60] Begin to be able to negotiate and solve problems without aggression [40-60]
