As readers, we will be continuing to develop our comprehension skills by reading a wide variety of texts.

As writers, we will be focusing on organising our ideas using the features of a non-fiction text. We will research and make notes and write our own non-fiction text using the key features.

We will also continue to independently proofread our own work for spelling and punctuation errors.

Geography:

As geographers, we will be exploring ways to improve an area of our local environment.

Computing:

As computer scientists we will be learning about computer networks as well as using coding programmes.

Maths:

As mathematicians, we be working on fractions. We will be counting up and down in tenths, recognising, finding, writing and comparing fractions of a set of objects and numbers. We will learn to recognise and show equivalent fractions and add and subtract fractions with the same denominator. We will also be learning to tell and write the time from an analogue clock.
