Although Read Write Inc. Phonics and Fresh Start follow a similar phonics progression the texts in the two programmes are not interchangeable. The pace of Fresh Start is much faster than the Phonics progression. The Phonics progression has more review built into it, e.g. at Purple, Orange and Yellow levels. Hence, this correlation is only a best fit.

The chart shows the closest match to the phonics focus in the Modules and Anthologies texts to the Phonics eBooks. However, there will be differences in the Red Words and Story Green Words practised.
